# Information for Schools and Early Childhood Education Centres in Havelock North 

$14^{\text {th }}$ August 2016
A boil water notice was issued by Hastings District Council on Friday 12 August 2016 as a result of contamination found in the Havelock North water supply. This has resulted in an outbreak of vomiting and diarrhoea among the Havelock North community and people who may work, or have visited the community, and consumed contaminated water.

Residents in Havelock North have been advised that until the Boil Water Notice is lifted they need to boil their water before drinking or using it. View/download a Boil Water Advisory Fact Sheet.

Please find some key messages for Schools and Early Childhood Education Centres.

## Drinking Water

- It is important that children do not access unsafe water. Advise children on where they can drink safe water and put up signage.
- Turn off, and clearly mark, any drinking water sources that are not safe.
- Ask parents to supply children with their own labelled water bottles. This may be bottled water or water that has been through the boiling/cooling process.


## Sick children should stay away from school or ECE

- Children who have had diarrhoea or vomiting should be kept at home until they have had no symptoms for at least 48 hours.
- If a child develops symptoms their parents should be contacted immediately.
- If a staff member develops symptoms they need to be sent home immediately.


## Promote good hand washing technique

- Children, caregivers and their families/whānau should wash their hands thoroughly with soap and warm running water for 20 seconds. Hands should be dried thoroughly for 20 seconds, with paper towels. If paper towels are not viable some other method which presents a fresh drying surface to each user should be used (for instance cloths or towels that are laundered between uses).

Children, caregivers and families/whānau should wash and dry their hands:

- After going to the toilet
- Before eating
- Before handling food or food utensils
- After handling pets or other animals
- After blowing their nose
- Before and after changing children's nappies.


## Dehydration

Children can get dehydrated if they have prolonged illness with vomiting and diarrhoea. Encourage them to drink fluids.

- Offer clear fluid even if vomiting.
- Give small amounts frequently, for example one teaspoon every five minutes.

Suggested fluids:

- Water that is either bottled or been boiled.
- Diluted fruit juice / cordial / lemonade (dilute a quarter cup of juice with three quarters of a cup of bottled or boiled water).
- Rehydration solutions (such as gastrolyte) are available from your chemist or doctor.

Do not drink sports drinks - they can make diarrhoea worse as they contain too much sugar.

## If symptoms persist they should see their family doctor.

## Activities

Children who have had diarrhoea must not swim or paddle in any pool until they have had: no symptoms for at least two weeks after symptoms have ceased,

## Clarification for schools, early childhood centres and Te Kohanga Reo cryptosporidium and giardia

There have been varying media reports regarding "bugs" in the Havelock North water supply including cryptosporidium and giardia. This is not "new" news as the boil water notice (for Havelock North residents) was put in place from the outset of the outbreak to kill the cryptosporidium; and chlorine added to the water supply in Havelock North and Hastings will kill giardia.

We are monitoring with extra surveillance, including monitoring absences. We have requested schools, Te Kohanga Reo and early childhood centres report - 'higher than usual rates of health related absences'. In Havelock North we are visiting schools. This monitoring is required as both cryptosporidium and giardia have longer incubation periods (the time between infection and the onset of the first symptoms) than campylobacter. We are remaining vigilant.

Currently the small numbers of people with cryptosporidium and giardia is normal for this time of year. There is no evidence to suggest another outbreak from a different source.
