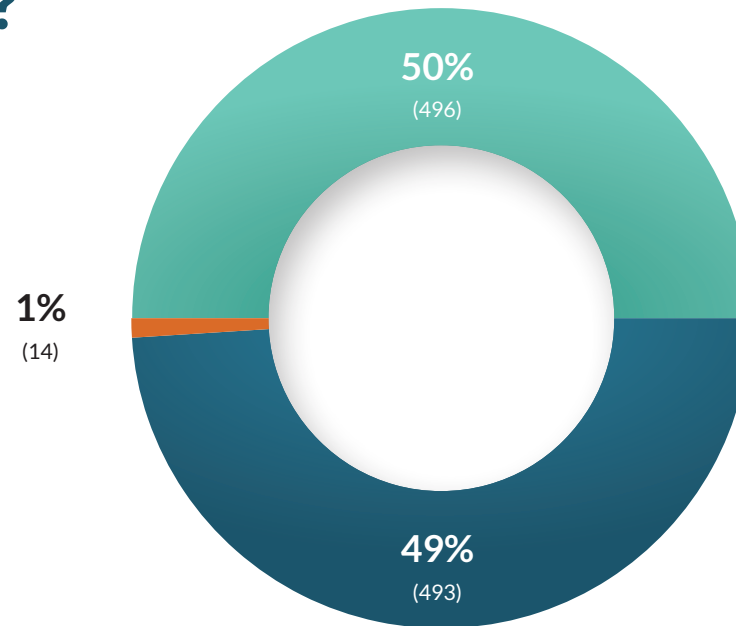


Since the COVID-19 lockdown, have you purchased wet wipes?

*'Yes' breakdown

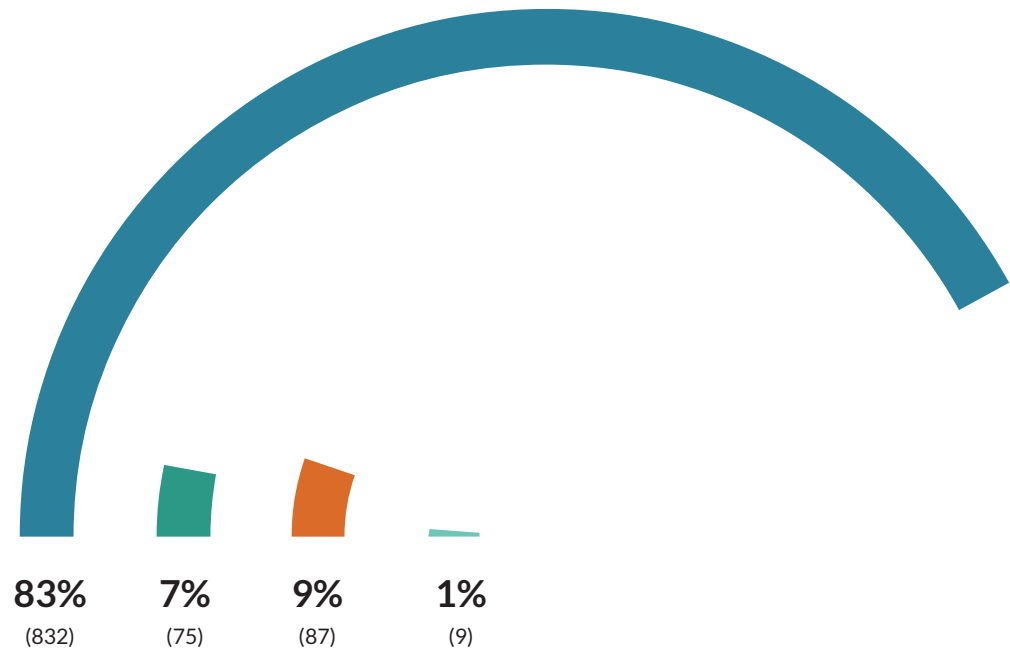
- ◆ 8% - Yes, and many more than I normally buy

- ◆ 8% - No, there were none in the shop

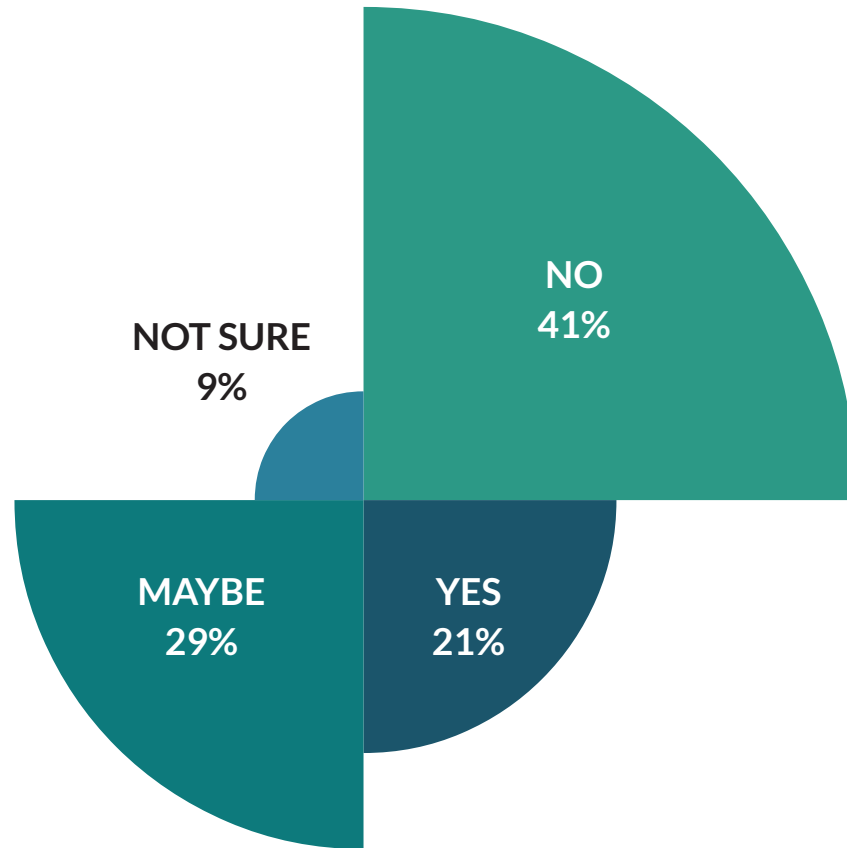
Did you know wet wipes should not be flushed down the toilet, even if the packet says they are 'flushable'?

- ◆ Not sure - 9%



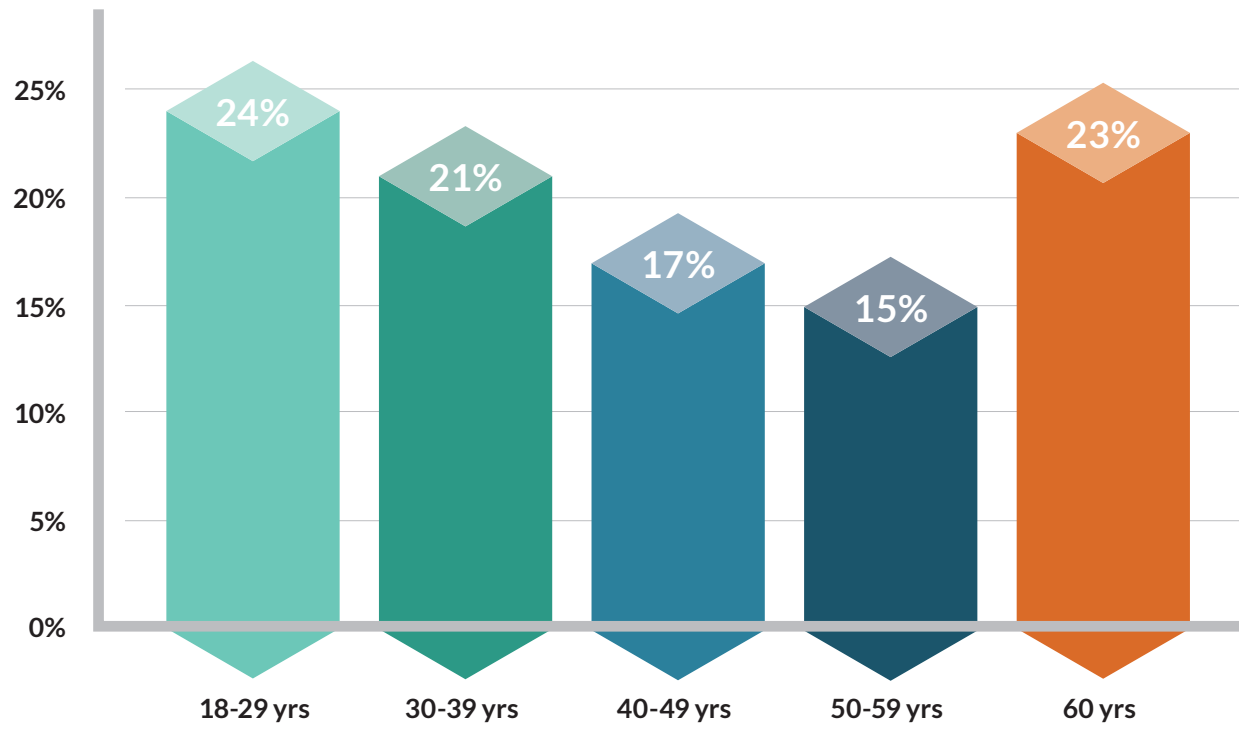
*'No' breakdown

*'Yes' breakdown

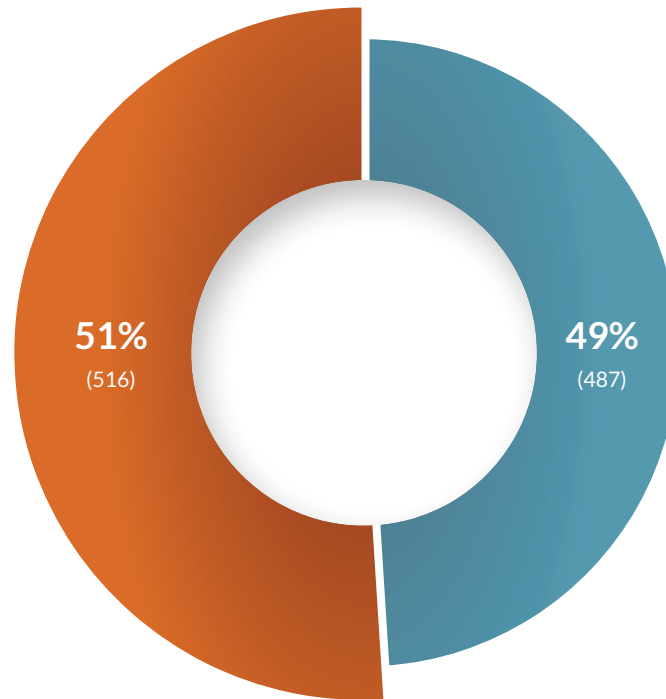
- ◆ 7% - Yes, wet wipes should be banned particularly once COVID-19 is over
- ◆ 14% - Yes, wet wipes should definitely be banned

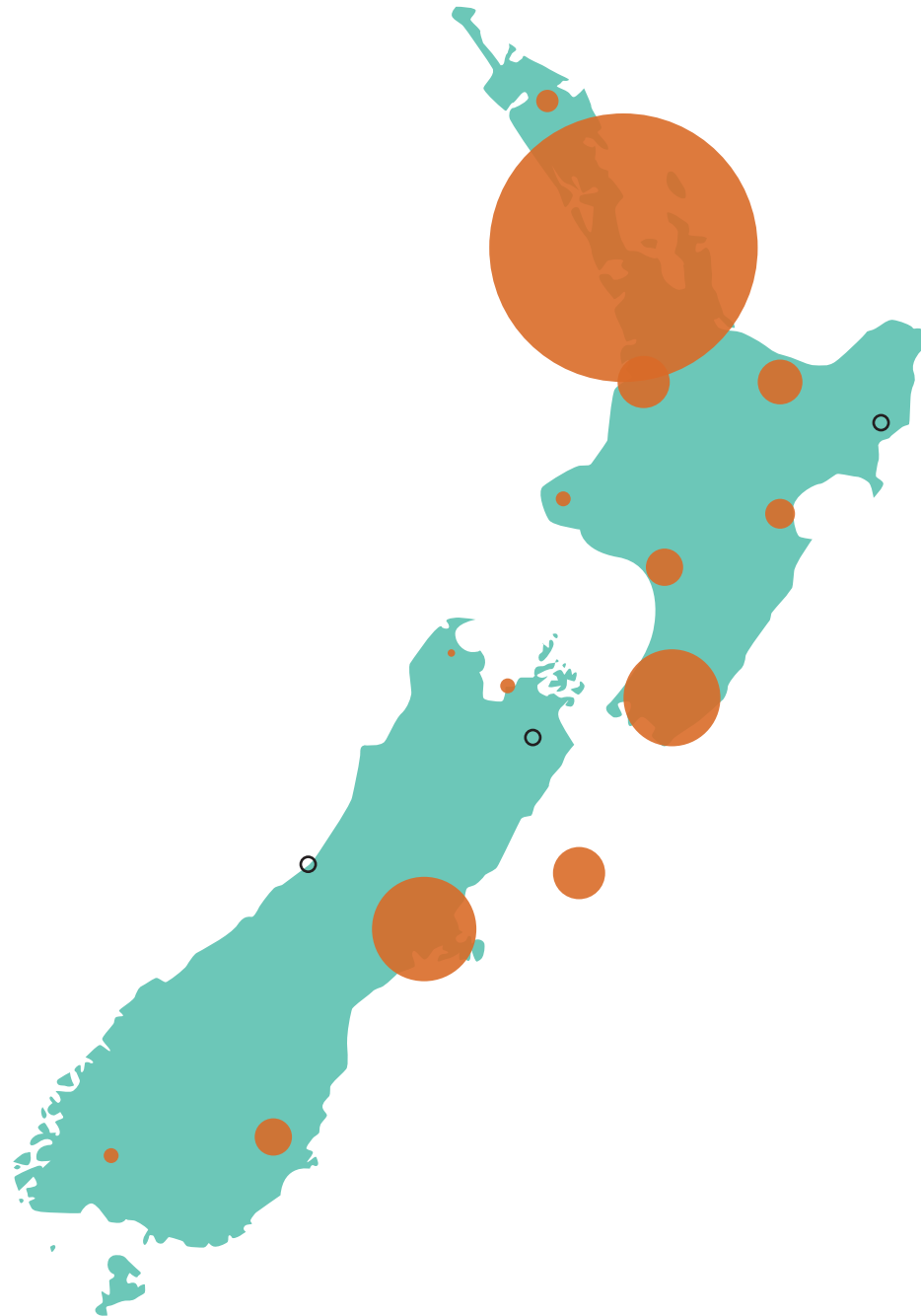
Age Group
